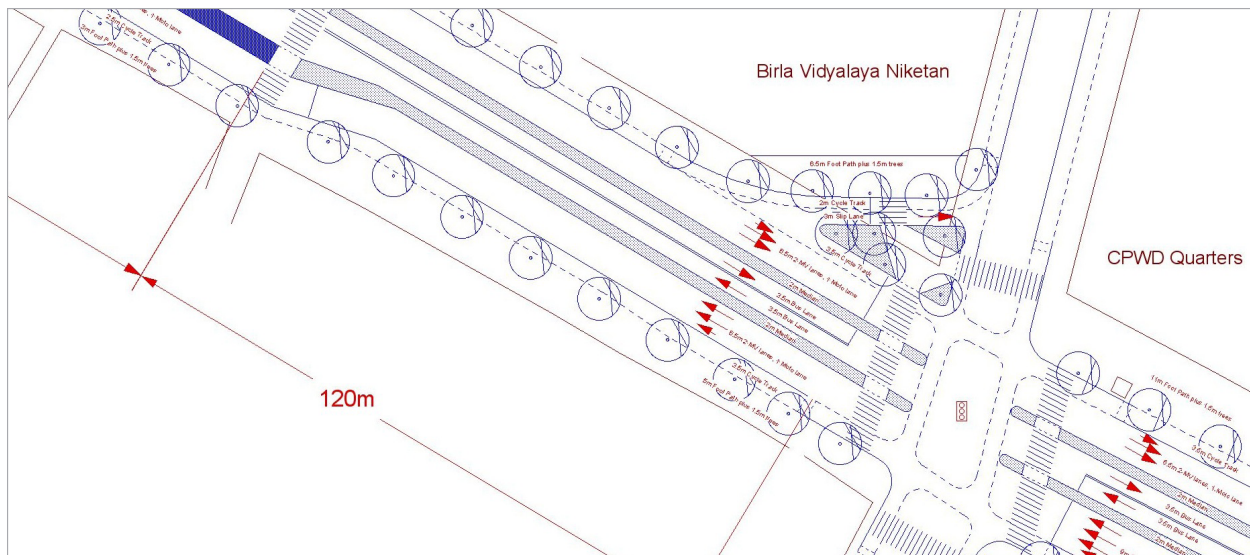


Non-Motorized Transport Projects



Nelson\Nygaard Principal Michael King has been working on non-motorized transport projects in India through the Institute for Transportation and Development Policy since 2003.

In Ahmedabad, he provided technical support to the Environmental Planning Collaborative (www.epconnet.com) for 100 km of bicycle facilities. This included 60 km along the proposed bus rapid transit corridor and 40 km on other streets.

In New Delhi, Michael worked with the Transportation Research and Injury Prevention Programme at the Indian Institute of Technology—Delhi (<http://www.iitd.ac.in/tripp/>) on the High Capacity Bus System project. He provided technical support, critical commentary of the pedestrian and bicycle infrastructure, and corridor design assistance. A highlight was a presentation on pedestrian safety to the Delhi Police Commission.
