

Transbay Terminal Improvement Program



Nelson\Nygaard led the transit operations component for this project, which developed consensus among numerous local and regional transit operators, four key cities, an inter-regional Greyhound terminal, and the Metropolitan Transportation Commission, resulting in a unified vision for a new Transbay Terminal.

The firm was specifically responsible for programming for each of the many transit operators who use the terminal, ensuring the highest level of operations could be conducted in the terminal, and evaluating the costs and benefits to the operators and the passengers under a variety of terminal scenarios.

Nelson\Nygaard's project manager was responsible for ensuring that all of the functional requirements for Greyhound Bus Lines were being met.
